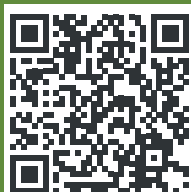
## Unlock Benefits to Empowering Young Adults with IDD's

In Arizona, joint filers can receive up to \$841 for their contribution to a Qualified Charitable Organization (QCO), and single filers can receive up to \$421.



Step 1:
